TERM OF AGREEMENT:

This Agreement shall begin on the date of execution and continue until terminated by either party in accordance with this Agreement's

1. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

The Caregiver agrees to provide elder care services to the Care Recipient, which may include but are not limited to assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs), medication reminders, companionship, transportation, housekeeping, meal preparation, and other personal care services as mutually agreed upon.

2. COMPENSATION

The Care Recipient agrees to pay the Caregiver at a rate of \$_____ per hour/session/day as applicable. Payment shall be made on a _____ basis and by the following method(s): _____.

3. HOURS OF CARE

Care services shall be provided during the following days and hours:

4. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing written notice to the other party at least ____ days in advance. Termination may also occur immediately upon mutual agreement or for cause, including but not limited to breach of this Agreement or conduct detrimental to the Care Recipient.

5. CAREGIVER'S DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Caregiver shall perform services diligently and with reasonable care and skill, maintain confidentiality of all personal and medical information related to the Care Recipient, comply with all applicable laws and regulations, and promptly report any emergencies or changes in the Care Recipient's condition.

6. CARE RECIPIENT'S DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Care Recipient agrees to provide a safe environment for care, supply necessary medical information and emergency contacts, and communicate any changes in health or care needs promptly to the Caregiver.

7. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS

The Caregiver is an independent contractor and not an employee, agent, or partner of the Care Recipient. The Caregiver is responsible for all taxes, insurance, and benefits related to the provision of services.

8. LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

The Caregiver shall perform services with reasonable care and skill but shall not be liable for any injuries or damages resulting from the Care Recipient's own negligence or failure to follow medical advice. The Care Recipient agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Caregiver from any claims arising out of the Care Recipient's own actions or omissions.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Caregiver agrees to maintain confidentiality of all private and medical information of the Care Recipient and shall not disclose such information to any third party without prior written consent except as required by law.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes arising under this Agreement shall be resolved first through good faith negotiations between the parties. If unresolved, the parties agree to submit the dispute to mediation before seeking any other legal remedy.

11. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the applicable state law where the Care Recipient resides, without regard to conflict of law principles.

12. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may only be amended or modified by a written document signed by both parties.

13. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior oral or written agreements or understandings concerning the subject matter herein.

14. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
