

GEORGIA PRENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties contemplate legal marriage under the laws of the State of Georgia and desire to establish their respective rights and responsibilities regarding each other's income and property and the income and property that may be acquired, either separately or together, during the marriage; and WHEREAS, the Parties aim to make a full and fair disclosure of their assets and liabilities and to enter into this Agreement voluntarily and without duress.

ARTICLE 1 – DISCLOSURE OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

Each Party has made a full and fair disclosure to the other Party of his or her property and financial obligations as of the date of this Agreement. The Parties acknowledge receipt of such disclosures.

ARTICLE 2 – SEPARATE PROPERTY

Each Party's separate property, including property owned prior to marriage, inheritances, gifts, and any income or appreciation thereof, shall remain the separate property of that Party, free from any claim by the other Party.

ARTICLE 3 – MARITAL PROPERTY

Property acquired during the marriage that is not separate property shall be considered marital property and shall be subject to equitable division upon dissolution of marriage, as provided by Georgia law.

ARTICLE 4 – SPOUSAL SUPPORT

In the event of dissolution of marriage, neither Party shall claim spousal support, maintenance, or alimony from the other Party, except as otherwise agreed in writing or ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction.

ARTICLE 5 – DEBTS

Each Party shall be responsible for his or her separate debts incurred before or during the marriage, and neither Party shall be liable for the separate debts of the other Party.

ARTICLE 6 – WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Each Party waives any and all rights to the separate property of the other Party that may arise by virtue of the marriage, including but not limited to rights of dower, curtesy, elective share, and homestead rights.

ARTICLE 7 – GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia without regard to principles of conflicts of law.

ARTICLE 8 – AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended or revoked only by a written agreement signed by both Parties.

ARTICLE 9 – VOLUNTARY EXECUTION

Each Party acknowledges that he or she has had the opportunity to consult with independent legal counsel of his or her choosing, has read and understands all provisions of this Agreement, and executes this Agreement voluntarily, without duress or undue influence.

ARTICLE 10 – EFFECT OF MARRIAGE

This Agreement shall become effective upon the Parties' marriage and shall remain in effect during the marriage except as modified or terminated as provided herein.

ARTICLE 11 – SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

ARTICLE 12 – ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the Parties and supersedes any prior agreements, whether oral or written.
