Recitals:

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to enter into this Marriage Contract Agreement to set forth their respective rights, duties, and obligations; and WHEREAS, this Agreement shall be binding upon both Parties pursuant to the laws of the United States of America.

Section 1 – Purpose and Intent

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions agreed upon by Party One and Party Two concerning their marriage, rights, responsibilities, and property arrangements. Both Parties enter into this Agreement voluntarily and with full understanding.

Section 2 – Separate Property

Each Party shall retain sole ownership and control over all property, assets, and debts owned prior to the marriage, as well as any inheritance or gifts received individually during the marriage, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Section 3 – Marital Property

Property acquired during the marriage jointly or individually shall be considered marital property unless specified otherwise. The Parties agree to share, divide, or manage marital property in accordance with this Agreement and applicable state law.

Section 4 – Financial Responsibilities

The Parties agree to contribute to household expenses, debts, and financial obligations in a manner mutually agreed upon and consistent with their financial capabilities.

Section 5 – Debts and Liabilities

Any debts incurred before or during the marriage shall be the responsibility of the Party who incurred them unless expressly agreed otherwise. Both Parties shall disclose all known debts prior to execution of this Agreement.

Section 6 – Spousal Support and Alimony

In the event of dissolution of marriage, the Parties agree to negotiate spousal support and alimony consistent with

applicable state law and equitable considerations.

Section 7 – Children

This Agreement does not address child custody, support, or visitation rights. Such matters shall be determined separately in accordance with the best interests of the children and applicable law.

Section 8 – Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this Agreement shall be resolved through good faith negotiations, mediation, or arbitration before seeking judicial intervention.

Section 9 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____, without regard to its conflict of law principles.
