Section 1 – Custody and Residential Schedule

The parties agree to joint legal custody of the child(ren). The residential schedule shall be as follows: Parent 1 shall have residential custody during the following days and times; Parent 2 shall have residential custody during the remaining days and times. Both parents agree to cooperate and communicate regarding the child(ren)'s needs and schedules.

Section 2 – Holidays and Special Days

The parents shall alternate or share holidays and special days according to the attached schedule. Adjustments to this schedule may be made by mutual agreement in writing.

Section 3 – Decision Making

Major decisions regarding the child(ren)'s education, health care, religion, and welfare shall be made jointly by both parents. Routine day-to-day decisions shall be made by the parent with residential custody at the time.

Section 4 – Visitation

Non-residential parent shall have reasonable visitation rights, including but not limited to weekends, school vacations, and other times as mutually agreed. Supervised visitation may be ordered if deemed necessary.

Section 5 – Transportation

Transportation for custody exchanges shall be shared equally between the parents unless otherwise agreed. Pickup and drop-off locations shall be specified in the attached schedule.

Section 6 – Communication

Both parents shall encourage and facilitate frequent and meaningful communication between the child(ren) and the other parent through phone, video calls, or other reasonable means.

Section 7 – Child Support

Child support obligations shall be determined according to applicable state guidelines and laws. Payments shall be made in accordance with the court order or mutual agreement.

Section 8 – Medical and Dental Care

Both parents shall have access to the child(ren)'s medical and dental records. Emergency decisions may be made by the parent with physical custody, with notification to the other parent as soon as practicable.

Section 9 – Education

Both parents shall have access to educational records and shall be involved in school-related activities and decisions.

Section 10 – Relocation

Neither parent shall relocate the primary residence of the child(ren) outside the existing school district or more than ____ miles without prior written consent of the other parent or court approval.

Section 11 – Dispute Resolution

In the event of disputes concerning this Parenting Plan, the parties agree to attempt mediation prior to seeking court intervention.

Section 12 – Modification

This Parenting Plan may be modified by mutual written agreement of the parties or by court order upon a showing of changed circumstances.

Section 13 – Miscellaneous Provisions

Both parents agree to promote a positive relationship between the child(ren) and the other parent, to avoid speaking negatively about the other parent in the presence of the child(ren), and to adhere to the terms of this Parenting Plan in good faith.
