

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF [FULL NAMES OF SPOUSES]

I. IDENTIFICATION OF TESTATORS

We, [Full Name of Spouse 1] and [Full Name of Spouse 2], spouses residing at [Full Address], being of sound mind and legal capacity, do hereby declare this to be our Joint Last Will and Testament and revoke all prior wills, codicils, and testamentary dispositions made by either of us.

II. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTOR(S)

A. COMMUNITY PROPERTY

If one of us survives the other, all community property shall pass to the surviving spouse absolutely and in fee simple.

2. If Both Predecease

If both of us die simultaneously or under circumstances where it is impossible to determine who died first, our community property shall be distributed equally among our children listed below.

B. SEPARATE PROPERTY

Each of us directs that our separate property shall be distributed according to the following provisions:

1. Spouse 1's Separate Property

2. Spouse 2's Separate Property

If we have minor children at the time of our deaths, we appoint [Guardian's Full Name], residing at [Guardian Address], as guardian of their persons and estates.

IV. PAYMENT OF DEBTS AND EXPENSES

We direct that all our just debts, funeral expenses, and expenses of administering our estates be paid as soon as practical after our deaths.

V. TAXES

All estate, inheritance, transfer, and succession taxes or governmental charges payable by reason of our deaths shall be paid from our residuary estates, without apportionment.

VI. SURVIVAL CLAUSE

A beneficiary must survive the decedent by at least 120 hours (five days) to take under this Will unless otherwise provided.

VII. NO CONTEST CLAUSE

If any beneficiary under this Will, or any person claiming under said beneficiary, contests this Will or any of its provisions, any share or interest in the estate given to such contesting beneficiary is hereby forfeited and shall become part of the residuary estate.

VIII. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

A. Simultaneous Death: If both of us die simultaneously or under circumstances where it is difficult to determine who died first, it shall be presumed that [Full Name of Spouse 1] predeceased [Full Name of Spouse 2]. B. Governing Law: This Will shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of _____. C. Binding Effect: This Will shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of our heirs, successors, and assigns. D. Severability: If any provision of this Will is held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
